Planning For Success

I've been photographing newborns for over 8 years and can say with confidence that the best newborn portraits come from a seasoned photographer working with a happy, comfortable baby. They take patience, too!

with photographing babies. Use this little guide as a quick reference on how to make your session a huge success from start to finish!

I've put together some tips based on my extensive experience

PLAN AHEAD

I recommend booking your session at least 2-4 months in advance of your due date! As soon as baby comes, it's non-stop late nights and hard work for Mom and Dad. Coordinating a photo session seems like the last thing on your list of priorities. This is why I recommend booking your session in advance to make sure everything is lined up ahead of time and you don't have to worry! Once your little bundle of joy arrives, please contact me to let me know the good news. I will work closely with you or a family member to find a day and time that works for everyone. Newborns are best photographed under 4 weeks of age; the ideal timing before 12 days.

BEFORE THE SESSION

The day of our session, try not to stress too much. With a new baby - everything is new! It takes time to get into a rhythm with your little one, and predicting when naptime will happen is generally difficult. However, if you can manage to have baby fed and changed before the shoot, this will increase chances of sleep! If you have any outfits or props you'd like included in the photos, please lay them out ahead of time in a place easily accessible.

On the day of your session, it's possible that baby won't be feeling well. We can always changed the session type from lifestyle to posed at the last minute, or I may be able to reschedule within a short timeframe if my schedule allows. Please contact me immediately if there's an issue!

DURING THE SESSION

At just a few days old, a regular feeding, sleeping, and potty schedule is out of the question. I understand this, and will work with you to capture the best photos in the time allocated - and if it takes longer, we work longer!

Although I have my bag of tricks to make the process efficient and fun for everyone, it really all comes down to how baby's feeling. For posed sessions, I ask that parents wait nearby while I pose and photograph your sleeping newborn. I will call you in immediately if baby needs something or I need assistancel! Parents and families are welcomed and encouraged to participate during lifestyle photos.

TO KEEP IN MIND

- Newborns are best photographed under 4 weeks and ideally before 12 days.
- Have baby fed and changed before the session to increase chances of sleep!
- For posed sessions, I ask that parents wait in another room while I photograph baby to minimize distractions
- If you have any outfits or props you'd like included in the photos, please lay them out ahead of time
- If you plan to have a theme, please make sure you bring all the items you want in the photos
